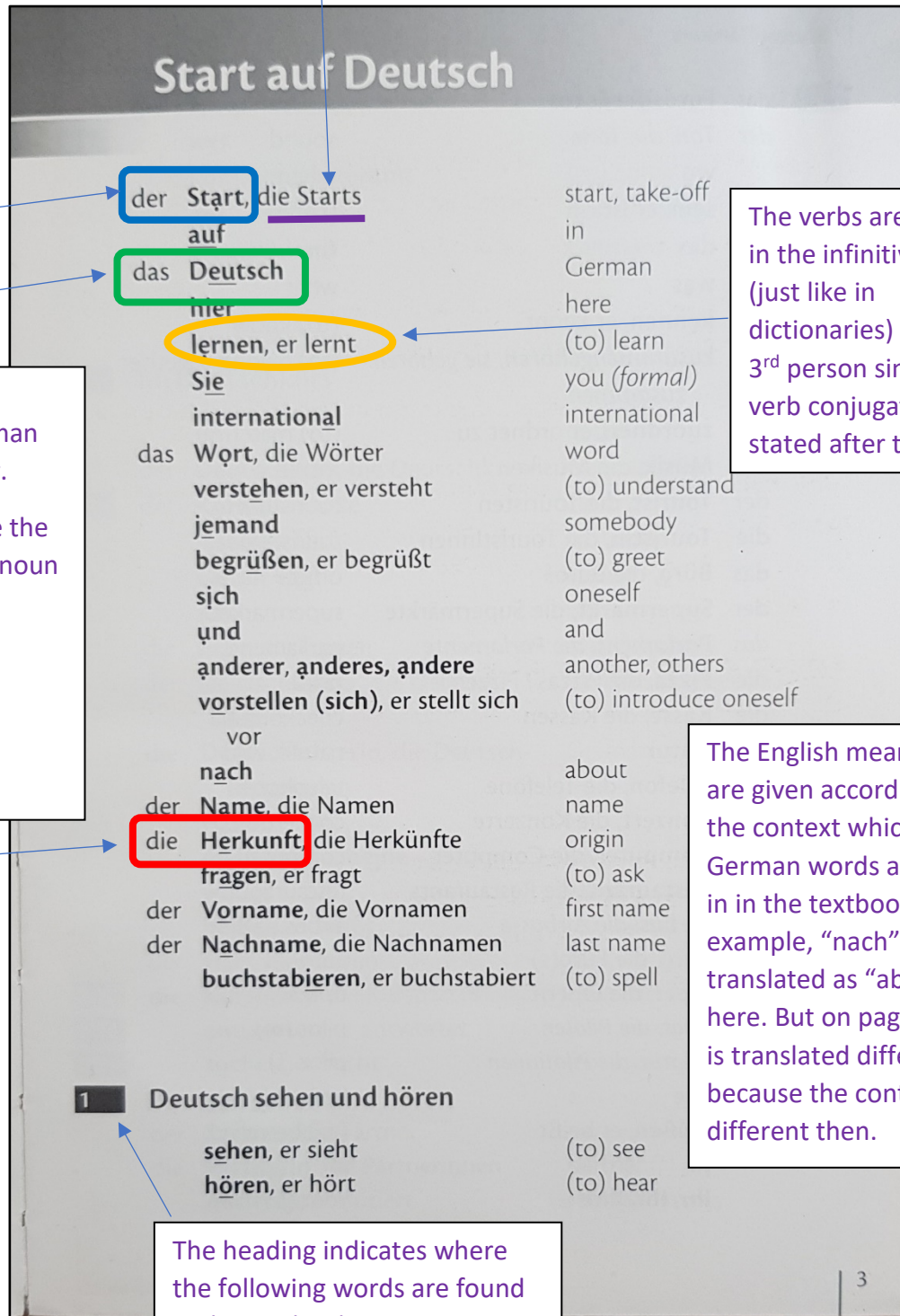


Glossary

A guide on how to use the “studio 21 A1” glossary

Most nouns have a plural form, which is stated after the singular form.



All nouns are capitalised in German and have a gender. The articles before the nouns denote the noun gender:

der -> masculine
 die -> feminine
 das -> neuter

The verbs are stated in the infinitive form (just like in dictionaries) and the 3rd person singular verb conjugation is stated after that.

The English meanings are given according to the context which the German words are used in in the textbook. For example, “nach” is translated as “about” here. But on page 22, it is translated differently because the context is different then.

The heading indicates where the following words are found in the textbook.
